Opening festival area: Friday, 18th of June 2010 at 7:00am

Start festival with 1st band: Friday, 18th of June 2010 at 11:00am

End of festival with last band: Saturday, 19th of June 2010 at 6:00am

Closing of camping area: Saturday, 19th of June 2010 at 5:00pm

Travel to the festival one day in advance is strongly recommended. There will be heavy traffic on the roads and also on the rails on friday!

Arrive on thursday evening, party and be the 1st to enter the festival-area on friday morning!

Says **LARS ULRICH/METALLICA** of this historic announcement:

"Who would have thought that more than 25 years after its inception, thrash metal's big 4 would not only still be around and more popular than ever, but will now play together for the first time...what a mindfuck! Bring it on!"

BACKGROUND NOTES

Having established itself as the "**Best New Festival**" at the 2009 UK Festival Awards and holding six out of eight of the nominations for the forthcoming "Best New Festival" category at the European Festival Awards, SONISPHERE FESTIVAL moves forward proudly with the announcement of their phenomenal 2010 headliners.
